If you have a tour that you think would be a good fit for our needs, please reach out to cnyapwa@gmail.com to get your tour on our 2025 meeting schedule!

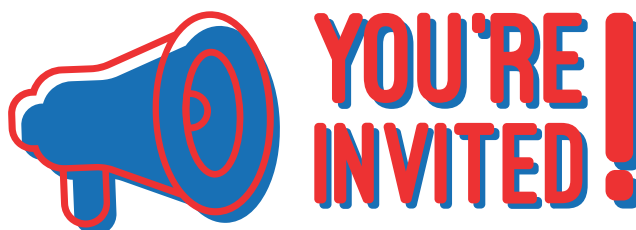
